POSITION: Literacy Tutor

TIME OF DAY: Morning or Afternoon depending on schedule

RESPONSIBILITIES: Literacy Tutors will offer one-on-one support to scholars by: (1) Listening to scholars read aloud (2) Reading aloud to scholars (3) Asking clarifying questions to facilitate deeper understanding of the text (4) Assisting teachers with literacy activities (5) Providing active encouragement.

- Ability to make a weekly commitment
- Interest in and/or experience working with elementary school students
- Willingness to learn the best practices for literacy tutoring
- Current or past work/volunteer experience as a literacy tutor or a plus

TRAINING: All Literacy tutors are required to attend a scheduled 1.5 hour training with the Volunteer and Community Engagement Coordinator prior to entering the classroom.
