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## 5th Grade Updates

Everyday scholars have between 2-3 hours of online learning a day. They have activities to complete for Math, Reading, Science, Physical Education, and Spanish.

**Math:** calculating the volume of rectangular shapes

**Reading:** reading "City of Ember" and answering questions on the setting, characters, vocabulary, and figurative language.

**Science:** learning about how different structures in the body have different functions and understanding how scientists discover different structures and functions in the body.

**PE:** varying physical activities like yoga and soccer

**Spanish:** learning about the different types of Sciences in Spanish

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## 6th Grade Updates

Everyday scholars have between 2-3 hours of online learning a day. They have activities to complete for Social Studies, Math, Reading, Science, Physical Education, and Spanish.

**Math:** identifying and calculating 3 dimensional shapes and Khan Academy math practice

**Reading:** reading "Flush" and learning how to summarize the text and responding to questions about the characters.

**Social Studies:** learning about the Constitution, Bill of Rights, and the Electoral College.
