5th Grade Updates

Math: plot points, use them to draw lines in the plane, and describe patterns

Reading: read "City of Ember" and answer questions on characters, setting, and vocabulary

Science: use a model to explain why more light can make it more difficult for the Tokay gecko to see.

PE: individual fitness, yoga, and soccer skills

Spanish: identify and change verbs from future tense to past tenses and vice versa

6th Grade Updates

Math: review area of 2D shapes, shapes on the coordinate plane, volume of 3D shapes, surface area of 3D shapes

Reading: read "Flush" and answer questions on characters, setting, and vocabulary

Science: learn that energy is released during chemical reactions and that in chemical reactions atoms can't be created or destroyed

Social Studies: analyze historical documents about the rights and duties of citizenship and write an essay

PE: individual fitness, yoga, and soccer skills
